NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to the qualified electors of the **Modesto City Schools District** (the "District") located in the County of Stanislaus, State of California, that in accordance with applicable law, an election will be held on Tuesday, November 8, 2022, in the District, at which election there will be submitted to the voters the question of whether the District shall be authorized to issue and sell bonds of up to \$198 million in aggregate principal amount to provide financing for the specific high school facilities projects list in the Bond Project List.

Said measure will be referred to as "Measure L." This measure will become effective only if approved by 55% of those voters voting on the measure.

To update career training classrooms, labs/equipment to prepare students for the workforce; repair leaking roofs/deteriorating plumbing; and update classrooms/science labs for quality instruction in math, science, reading/writing, shall the Modesto City High School District measure be adopted authorizing \$198,000000 in bonds at legal rates, providing approximately \$9,700,000 annually at an estimated 2.9 cents per \$100 assessed value while bonds are outstanding, with citizen oversight, annual audits, no funds for administrator salaries, and funds used locally?

ARGUMENTS FOR OR AGAINST this measure may be submitted to the county elections official at the office thereof at 1021 "I" Street, Suite 101, Modesto, California, not later than 5:00 p.m., Thursday, July 28, 2022, determined by the county elections official under the authority of Section 9502 of the Elections Code. No argument shall exceed 300 words in length and the statement required in Section 9600 of the Elections Code must accompany all arguments.

REBUTTAL ARGUMENTS may be submitted to the county elections official on or before Friday, August 5, 2022, at 5:00 p.m. and must not exceed 250 words in length and must also be accompanied by the statement required in Section 9600 of the Elections Code.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that pursuant to current California election laws, all actively registered voters shall receive a vote by mail ballot. Vote centers will begin opening 10 days prior to Election Day to provide in person voting services. Language and accessibility assistance will be available at all voting locations. Secure ballot drop boxes will be available 29 days prior to Election Day. Vote center and secure ballot box locations, dates and times will be listed in the county voter information guide and posted on www.stanvote.com. All vote centers and the county elections office will be open 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Election Day, Tuesday, November 8, 2022.
